Seed Sedgemoor is delighted to invite the public to the launch of a brand new hardback book celebrating creativity, community, and individuality.

Join us on Friday 20th June at 11:00am at the Seed Creative Popup, Angel Place Shopping Centre, Bridgwater for a joyful gathering filled with readings, conversation, and refreshments.

Commissioned by Seed as part of *The Individuality Project*, this beautifully produced book captures the creative voices of Sedgemoor. Men and women of all ages took part in a series of inclusive creative writing workshops, drawing inspiration from the expressive ceramic figures of the individuality project to explore identity, imagination, and lived experience. The result is a powerful and heartfelt collection of personal and fictional stories told through both clay and words.

"Everybody has a story to tell," says project lead **Bridget Hemmings**. "This book is proof of that. It celebrates the voices and perspectives that make up the fabric of Sedgemoor life, funny, thoughtful and sometimes moving."

Several of the contributing writers will be giving live readings at the event, offering attendees the chance to hear their words first-hand and connect with the creativity sparked through this community-led process.

We believe that arts, culture and creativity are not elite activities, but should be an ordinary part of everyday life, created by, with and for the people. This can be achieved in partnerships with artists in all forms of the creative arts, working in response to the collective imagination and reflecting the things that are important to the communities of

Sedgemoor. We seek to make creative arts, culture and heritage part of everyday life in Sedgemoor by growing new opportunities for its people to participate, create and celebrate.

Seed is part of the Creative People and Places programme, supported using public funding by the National Lottery through Arts Council England. Thanks to National Lottery players, Creative People

and Places is about more people taking the lead in choosing, creating and taking part in creative and cultural experiences in the places where they live.
