Paint with Sound: Liquid Sounds Brings Sensory Art to Bridgwater

July 3

Seed Sedgemoor is delighted to commission Liquid Sounds, an interactive art installation and hands-on creative lab by synesthetic <u>artist bsp</u>, now open daily at The Creative Popup in Angel Place Shopping Centre, Bridgwater until Saturday 6th July.

Liquid Sounds invites the public to explore how sound can become colour, and how touch can become music. Using bsp's custom-built, touch-reactive canvases, visitors can create vibrant, multisensory artworks in real time. The installation is open from 10am to 2pm daily, with no booking required and free entry for all ages.

This unique experience offers a playful, inclusive space to experiment with art in a new way, particularly for those who may not see themselves as "creative." The project is inspired by bsp's lived experience of synaesthesia, a neurological condition that causes her to perceive sound as colour.

"Liquid Sounds is about giving people a new way to express themselves," says bsp. "It's about making art accessible, joyful, and truly for everyone."

The residency will culminate in a special community live painting performance on the final day, inviting everyone who has taken part throughout the week to contribute to one large-scale artwork.

Seed's aim is to enable more people in Sedgemoor to actively engage in the creative arts, particularly those who don't usually do so. The projects and events are supported by the Arts Council England via the Creative People and Places project.


